



**Aim: To create an “exploding” shape picture**



**Today we are going to make exploding shape pictures like the one below**





## This is what you need to do:

- You will need a square of coloured paper or card (*home learners- you can colour a piece of white paper if you need to*) and a second piece of paper on which you will stick your exploding shape.
- First, cut out shapes from **each side** of the square (**not** on the corners) You can cut just one shape from each side if they are quite big.
- Once the shapes have been cut out, stick what is left of the square into the middle of your second piece of paper.
- Then fit the cut out pieces back into the spaces like a jigsaw but **do not stick them down!**
- Next, take each cut out shape, one at a time, and flip it over so that it sits outside the square. The straight side needs to sit on the edge of the main square. (see previous slide)
- Repeat with the other cut out shapes.



**If you enjoyed it and have time, you could try making exploding pictures using different shapes in the middle.**
