When should you use capital letters?



Capital Letters

You should always use a capital letter:

- At the beginning of a sentence
- For the pronoun 'I'
- For proper nouns – names of actual or specific people, places, objects, films or book titles.

For example: **T**heo, **M**iss **F**enton, **A**pril, **M**onday, **I**taly, '**I**ce **A**ge'

- joh is coming to my house next wednesday.

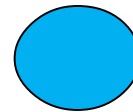
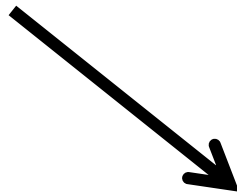

Full Stops

When should we use full stops?

**Small but
mighty**





Full Stop

- We place full stops at the end of statements i.e. a sentence which gives you information.

- For example:

Lara visited the zoo on Saturday.

- Nothing is being asked and there is no strong emotion so we use a full stop to show that the sentence is complete.
