SPaG: What Is Past Tense?


The past tense tells us what has already happened.





James Cook was a was a British explorer, navigator and cartographer (drew maps).



He sailed and discovered the Hawaiian Islands and the east coast of Australia.

We are going to learn more about him and his adventures later in the week.

Neil Armsrong was the first person to walk on the moon.

He landed on the moon 20th July 1969 in the space rocket Apollo 11.

There were two other astronauts with him Michael Collins and Buzz Aldrin.

Lift off was on 16th July 1969 and it took 4 days 6 hours 45 minutes to get there.
