

*Questions are sentences that ask you something.
They usually end with a question mark.*

What did you have for dinner?*

They are often urgent or angry, can be very short and contain an imperative verb. Commands Imperative verbs are also known as 'bossy verbs' - they tell people what to do.

*Example:
Help me! Stop it.*
