Australia!


Australia is one of the most unique countries in the world!



What is a continent?

A **continent** is a large solid area of land.


Earth has seven **continents**.

In order from largest to smallest, they are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe, and Australia.

The 7 continents are separated by 5 main oceans.
