
# The Great Barrier Reef



#### Coral and coral reefs

The living part of a coral is made up of tiny creatures called polyps, which are relatives of sea anemones. Polyps often live together in large colonies, snatching food from the water with their tentacles. Coral polyps protect themseves by building hard cases or tubes out of minerals. Over millions of years, these cases form giant coral reefs, which provide homes to enormous numbers of other sea creatures.

#### **Facts**

The Great Barrier Reef is the largest living structure on the planet, it is incredibly rich and diverse.

It stretches for 2300 km and is so large it can even be seen from outer space.

Its colourful reefs are home for a huge number of plants and animals.

This includes:

600 types of corals

more than 100 species of jellyfish

1625 types of fish

133 varieties of sharks and rays

more than 30 species of whales and dolphins.

It can even be seen from outer space.


It is bigger than the United Kingdom, Holland and Switzerland put together. It is bigger than Tasmania and Victoria put together.
