In the sky.

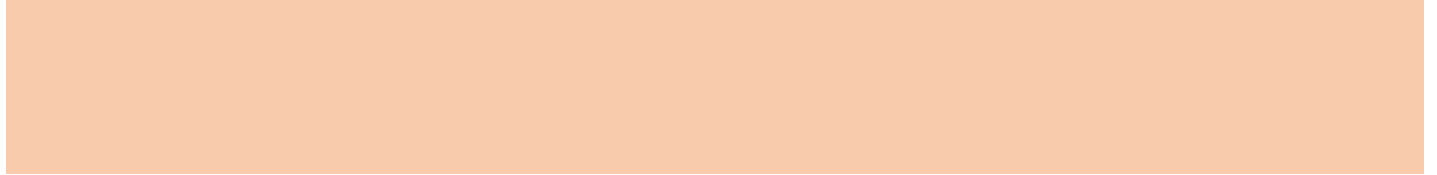


KANGAROO

Living in your pouch!

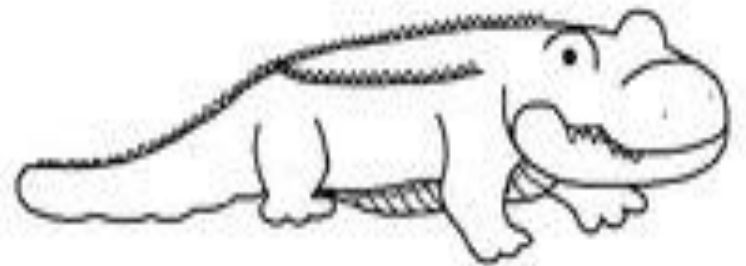




I'm a little possum
