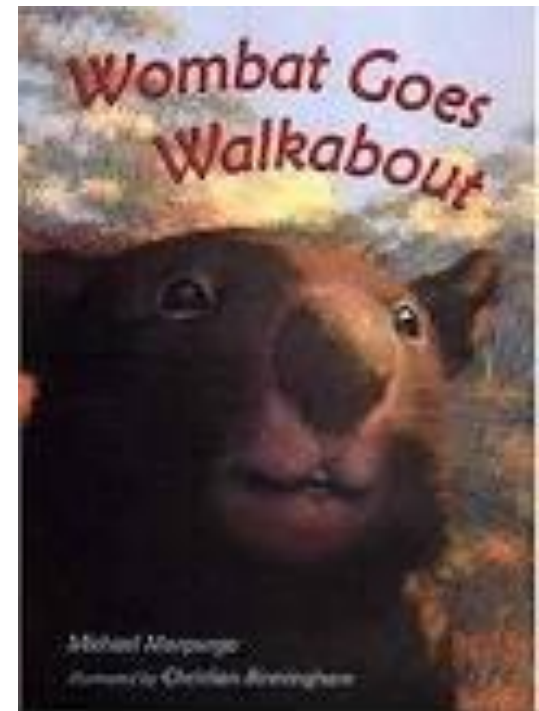


Wombat Goes Walkabout

swimming slowly

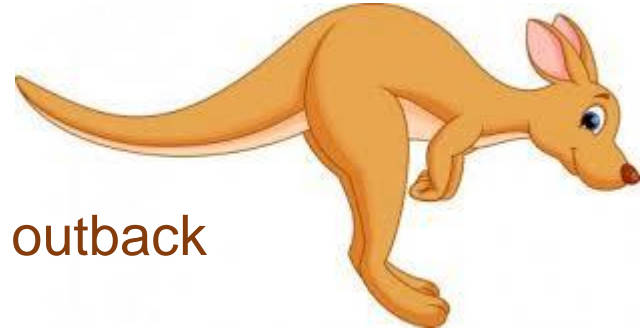
